1. **Picnic!** Always a fun family outing that makes for great memories and even cuter pictures. Pack all your family's favorites, either homemade, or support a local restaurant and order some goodies ahead. Grab a blanket and some cool drinks and take the family to one of the many scenic parks right here in Highland Village.

4. **Enjoy the local lakes!** Whether it's fishing, kayaking, or boating, there are so many great places to visit just minutes from the neighborhood. Lake Bridgeport is just a short drive as well and offers plenty of outdoor activities. Head west on 380 and enjoy this often overlooked lake.
5. **Explore right here in Castlewood.** Take a walk or bike ride, visit the playground, check out other areas you do not see everyday and get inspiration for some new projects at your own home.
6. **Visit Main Street Texas.** Take the family to small town Texas and support local restaurants hit hard by the lockdown. Downtown Aubrey and Celina both have great places to eat, and plenty of outdoor options to enjoy some small town cooking without having to sit in a crowded dining room. Hop on 428, just north of Highland Village and take it Aubrey and then on to Celina for a scenic drive and some great food. Celina features a great town square and Aubrey offers plenty of places to eat outdoors.
7. **Visit a state park!** Day trips to local state parks are fun opportunities to take a nice drive and enjoy some fresh air. The following state parks are within a few hours of Castlewood:
Ray Roberts State Park, Cedar Hill State Park, Lake Mineral Wells State Park, Eisenhower State Park, Cleburne State Park and for a quick out of state day trip, one of my personal favorites, head north on I-35 and visit **Lake Murray State Park** in Oklahoma.
