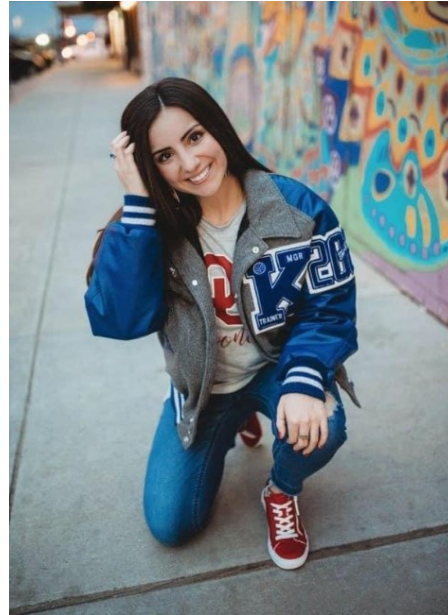
Sabrina Klein

Madison Wells



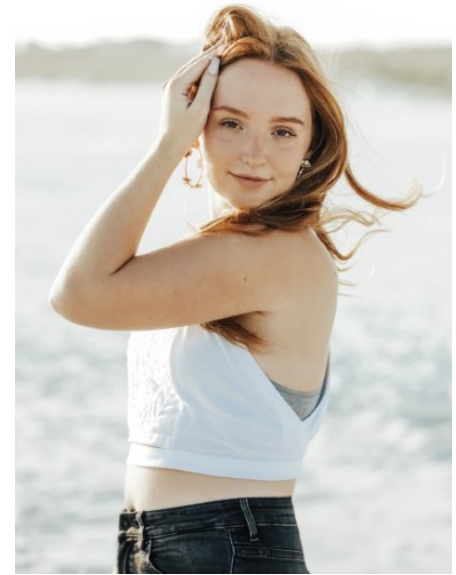
