Friendly Reminders From the Community Manager

Please help keep Castlewood a great place to live and be a good neighbor. Here are a few reminders/common violations found around the community.

- Trash cans should not be visible from the street. Trash and recycle bins can
 be placed out on Thursdays after 5 pm and should be stored out of view by
 Friday evening.
- Do not store recreational equipment on your porch or driveway. This
 includes bicycles, skateboards, scooters, portable basketball goals, portable
 soccer nets etc. Please be sure to store these items out of view of your
 neighbors when not in use.
- Basketball goals must be properly weighted and placed in a location approved by the Modifications Committee. If you have recently purchased a basketball goal, please submit an application to the Modifications Committee. Applications can be found at www.castlewoodhoa.com. Email your application to jhansen@spectrumam.com.
- Basketball goals are never permitted in the street for the safety of both the children and residents.
- If you plan to bring a boat, RV, or trailer home, please notify the community manger at jhansen@sepectrumam.com. Non permitted vehicles cannot be left on driveways for extended periods of time and will be issued a violation which can lead to a daily fine of \$10.
- Be sure to clean up grass clippings after mowing and mowing should always include edging around flower beds, fencing, landscaping etc.
- Mailboxes should be free of rust and visible wear and be painted black including the base.

If you receive a violation and have an extenuating circumstance, please contact the community manager immediately to make arrangements or request an extension to cure the violation.


