Katie Lovejoy



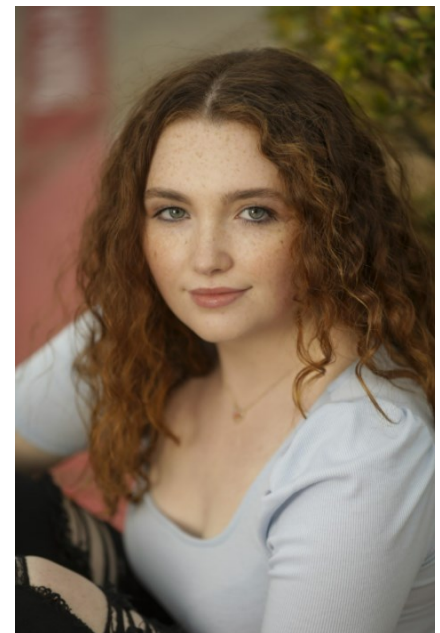

Ryan Murphy



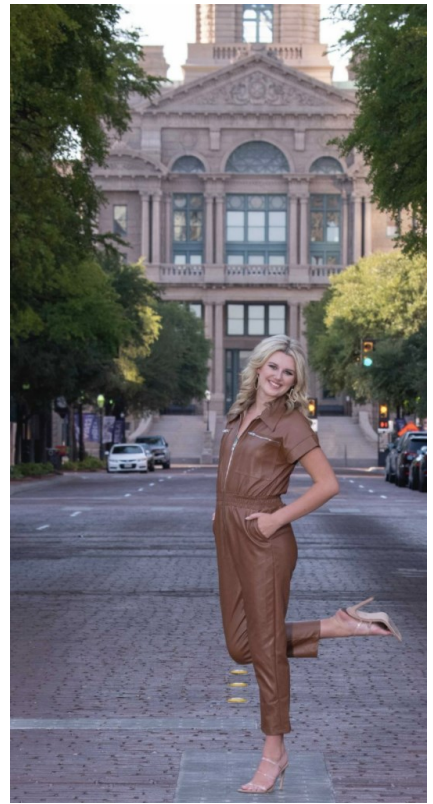
After graduation Ryan plans to attend Oklahoma State University in the fall and will study either Finance or Kinesiology.
