

As a prerequisite for granting a reservation, the Resident making the reservation must complete review and sign a copy of this document to serve as their request to use reserve the soccer field. Requests will be reviewed and added to the calendar once the community manager has approved them.

- Only residents in good standing may reserve the field.
- Residents assumes full responsibility for their team, coaches, parents, etc. This includes conduct and damage or disrepair to the field.
- Parents must utilize the soccer field parking lost first. If the lot is full, parents are to park along the west side of Fairfield (side closest to the field) only. Parents are not to park in front of homes for any reason. Complaints against a team may result in cancellation of reservation both present and future.
- Residents may not rent the field on behalf of another team, group, or organization, unless a member of the team or coaching staff is a Resident.
- All HOA-organized community events will have priority over private requests.
- The field is for practice only, teams may not schedule games against other teams on the field.
- Pets are not permitted on the field of play and must be on a leash. If a pet is present, all appropriate cleanup is expected.
- All garbage must be picked up.
- If the field is in need of maintenance, please contact the community manager.
- The Association reserves the right to revoke any request/approval if sufficient cause is found that any misrepresentation of the facts related to the field reservation occurred.
- Continuous complaints or violations against a team can result in cancellation of reservation both present and future.
- Complaints or concerns should be addressed to the community manager 972-317-2457. In case of emergencies call 911.
- The Association reserves the right to change any of the terms of this policy at its sole discretion, without prior notice.
- Release and Indemnification.
