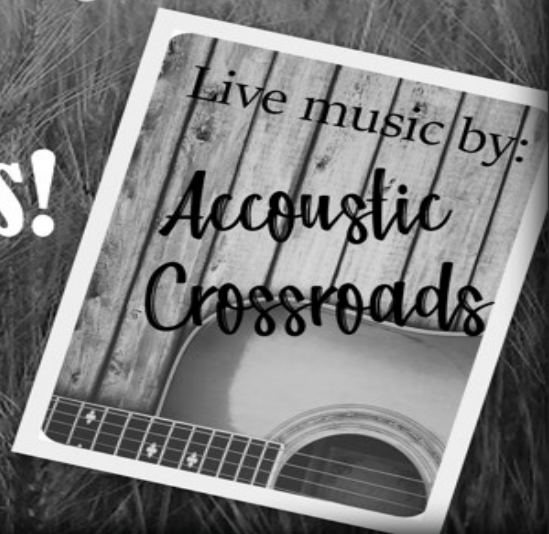

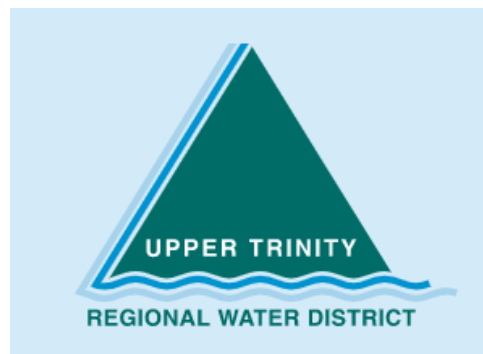
Water My Yard Program

My name is Larry Patterson, (Executive Director – Upper Trinity Regional Water District) and a longtime resident of Castlewood. I am always amazed at the outdoor water practices of some folks in our community. The high temperatures and less than normal rainfall signal that we are headed into a period of drought - - hopefully not for too long! Therefore, I would like to offer a few comments regarding how we can all have beautifully landscaped yards and still save water and money!

Water Utility studies have shown that as much as 50% of landscape water is wasted due to overwatering, inefficient watering practices and broken or poorly maintained irrigation systems. Also, experts have found that keeping a healthy yard requires less water than you may think. The 'Water My Yard' program can assist you in determining an adequate amount of supplemental water that is needed to maintain a healthy lawn.

'Water My Yard' uses local weather data (weather stations installed within the county by UTRWD) and the plants' water needs to provide weekly recommendations to let you know exactly how long to water. By signing up at WaterMyYard.org and selecting the appropriate sprinkler type(s), residents will receive a weekly email or text for how many minutes to run their sprinklers during the week, conserving water resources for the future and saving you money right now.
