

## Pet Etiquette Do's & Don'ts

## Going for a walk? Do keep your pet on a leash?

It creates a sense of comfort for anyone you encounter. Just because you know your pet is well-mannered and has strong recall skills doesn't mean your neighbors do. Seeing an unleashed dog walking toward them can make anyone nervous, especially children and elders.

Don't let your pet urinate on other people's lawns, shrubs, trees, mailboxes, or any other piece of property? Clean up waste as it occurs, and always bring extra baggies.

**Do** keep your pet close as other dogs pass. Always ask the owner's permission before you and your dog approach them, and if the owner declines, don't make objections. If both sides agree, let your dogs approach each other calmly and keep an eye out for aggressive behavior. If you encounter a person without pets, only let your dog approach if they ask. Don't allow your pet to jump on other dogs. It could lead to injury, and it's important your pet learns that not all canines enjoy this kind of interaction. Plus, you don't want your pet to have a reputation in the neighborhood for being that uncontrollable, jumpy dog.

#### At home

**Do** ensure that your pet is secured in the yard if you are leaving them outside for extended periods of time.

**Do** be sure your pet has a collar with the correct address and or current phone number.

#### **Fences in Need of Stain or Paint**


It is time to evaluate your fences. While many fences have a few more years left in them, they may need a fresh coat of stain or paint depending on the type of fence. Not only will this add to the appeal of your home, it will help prolong the life of your fence.

If your wrought iron fence is rusting or your wood fence has weathered and the stain has worn away, please plan to address this no later than *December 1, 2022*. If you plan to make any major changes to the look of your fence, be sure to submit an application to the Modifications Committee. Applications can be found at www.castlewoodhoa.com. Applications should be submitted to the community manager at jhansen@spectrumam.com.

If you will be staining or painting using the **existing color**, you may begin your project without an application. Wrought iron fences should be painted black and wood fencing should be finished on one side minimum per the governing documents. The "finished " side should be facing out. Fencing for areas which are adjoining a common green area or adjoining Army Corps of Engineers properties and/or easements shall be non-ornamental wrought iron of open type design and painted black.

Violations will be issued beginning December 1, 2022 to residents who have yet to address the issue and may result in fines of \$10 per day.


